### Criteria:

- BSW or MSW member of NASW-NE in good standing and upholds the Code of Ethics
- Has made major contributions to human services
- Has taken exceptional risk to better human services
- Has made superior contributions to the public knowledge of social work, social issues, and programs through advocacy for social workers
- Demonstrates exceptional leadership qualities
- Has not been a member of the NASW-NE Chapter Board of Directors during the last two years.
- You may nominate a person in more than one category.

## Lifetime Achievement Award

This award honors a colleague for a lifetime of excellence as a social worker.

### Criteria:

- Meets all the criteria for Social Worker of the Year
- Demonstrates repeated outstanding achievements
- Has been recognized beyond the social work profession
- Exhibits outstanding creativity and courage

## Public Citizen of the Year

This award honors a non-social worker who has displayed actions which demonstrate social work values.

### Criteria:

- Has made major contributions to human services
- Has taken exceptional risk to better human services
- Demonstrates exceptional leadership qualities

## Elected Public Official

This award honors a elected officials who have displayed actions which demonstrate social work values.

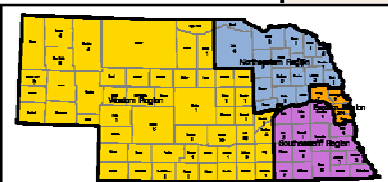
### Criteria:
