Sophia F. Dziegielewski is a Professor and Director of the School of Social Work, University of Cincinnati (UC), Cincinnati, Ohio.

Educational qualifications include her MSW and Ph.D. in Social Work from Florida State University, Tallahassee, FL.

Dr. Dziegielewski is a Licensed Clinical Social Worker in the state of Florida. Also, prior to arriving at UC she was Chairperson for the University of Central Florida Human Subjects Review Board, where she presided over all human subjects research at this large (43,000 students) metropolitan university. As of February 2006 she became Chairperson of the IRB, Behavioral Science Review Board for the University of Cincinnati. Throughout her social work academic and practice career she has been active in health and mental health clinical practice.

In the national magazine *Social Worker Today* in 2003 a feature story about Dr. Dziegielewski referred to her as a "legend in her field." She is the recipient of numerous awards, and supports her research and practice activity with over 110 publications, including 7 textbooks, 74 articles, numerous book chapters and over 500 workshops and community presentations.
